Application Requirements and Procedure	STEP 1: Apply to the International Office of SRH Hochschule Berlin in order to be nominated for a place at ISCTE. The deadline is the end of March prior to the academic year you wish to go abroad. STEP 2: Once you received your official nomination letter, you will need to apply to ISAG. Contact the International Office at ISAG to familiarize yourself with the application process and also with the admission requirements to determine whether or not you qualify for admission.
