Application Requirements and Procedure	STEP 1: Apply to the International Office of SRH Hochschule Berlin in order to be nominated for a place at MUP. The deadline is the end of March prior to the academic year you wish to go abroad. STEP 2: Once you received your official nomination letter, you will need to apply to MUP. Check http://www.mup.cz/en/international-cooperation/information-for-incoming-exchange-students/ to familiarize yourself with the application process and also with the admission requirements to determine whether or not you qualify for admission. (Some partner universities only accept students with a grade average of 2.0 or better, others may require you to have a minimum TOEFL score or may have other admission criteria.)
